



## Valley Forge Homestead Quilters

Since its inception in 1987, this guild has remained a dynamically active association. With a shared interest in quilts and quilting, coupled with a broad array of opportunities for learning and service, guild gatherings are filled with eager activity and a warm sense of fellowship.

General guild meetings occur on the third Tuesday of each month at 7pm (see map). Membership is open to all (dues \$25), and guests are welcome at a modest guest fee (\$5).

Other guild activities enable members to learn new techniques, improve general workmanship, participate in philanthropic endeavors, etc. while also building lasting friendships.

## Guild-Sponsored Activities

**Monthly Guild Programs**—Presentations from renowned quilting experts or delightful hands-on projects await members each month—plus door prizes, refreshments, warm camaraderie, and great fun (*3rd Tuesday at 7pm*).

**Workshops**—Skills building and/or specific project classes are offered to guild members (at reduced prices) about 6-times a year.

**Quilt Bees**—A daytime and three evening bees, are held monthly at various homes where participants work on their own projects, chat, eat, and enjoy each other's company.

**Quilt Retreats**—Expertly-planned weekend retreats are always a delight.

**Quilt Excursions**—An array of organized road trips to various quilt venues & events yield synergistically good times for all.

**Quilt Show**—This bi-yearly event offers an opportunity to publicly exhibit your work, enjoy the creations of others, and celebrate quilting—while raising funds for philanthropic & educational interests.

**Block of the month**—Patterns and instructions are offered each month, as well as monthly prize drawings for participants.

**Quilt Challenge**—This annual challenge inspires creativity and offers winning opportunities.

**Comfort quilts**—The unequalled comfort of quilts—created by guild members—is provided to those who are most in need of comfort in the Philadelphia area.

## Member Responsibilities

**Refreshments**—Contribute refreshments for general guild meetings periodically (usually once or twice a year).

**Quilt Show**—Participate in staffing our bi-annual quilt show.

**Raffle Quilt**—Sell and/or purchase a specific number of tickets for our bi-annual raffle quilt (typically a minimum of 10-dollars-worth).

**Comfort Quilts**—Assist with guild community outreach projects (contribute fabric and/or help make comfort quilts, and/or assemble kits, etc).

**Inform**—Read monthly newsletter to know what's going on.

**Dues**—Pay member dues in a timely manner.

**Membership Directory**—All contact information on guild members. Is available (for guild use only).

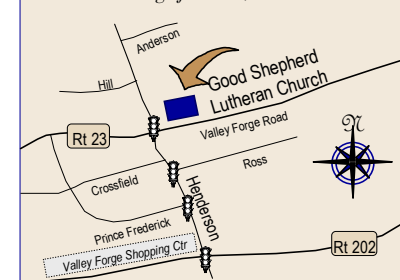
**Shopping Support**—A fabric shop directory, quilt book discounts through AQS, and the fact that guild membership cards are accepted for 10%
