General guild meetings occur on the third Tuesday of each month at 7pm (see map). Membership is open to all.

Other guild activities enable members to learn new techniques, improve general workmanship, participate in philanthropic endeavors, etc. while also building lasting friendships.

Guild-Sponsored Activities

Monthly Guild Programs—Presentations from renowned quilting experts or delightful hands-on projects await members each month—plus door prizes, refreshments, warm camaraderie, and great fun (3rd Tuesday at 7pm).

Workshops—Skills building and/or specific project classes are offered to guild members (at reduced prices) about 6-times a year.

Quilt Bees—Daytime and evening bees, are held monthly at various homes where participants work on their own projects, chat, eat, and enjoy each other's company.
